- Any exceptions from above need approval from instructor

Learning Resource Center (LRC)

- The Learning Resource Center (LRC) offers enrollment into the program at various levels of support, which is based upon student need. Services are fee-based and include, but are not limited to, sharing and strengthening executive functioning, study, test preparation, and test-taking skills. The LRC also manages accommodations for students with identified learning differences.
- Students work in small groups and may be assigned a “focus teacher” who facilitates those skills using content-area coursework. A parent’s main source of information on their child’s academic progress is via the online parent portal (PlusPortals). However, the focus teacher consistently communicates and collaborates student progress with teachers, parents and faculty/staff as needed.
- Students in need of specific content-area support may benefit from working with content tutors in the Achievement Center. Achievement Center tutors are available during the school day on a walk-in basis. Private tutors are also available for hire when individualized support is needed.
