

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT TRAVEL INFORMATION

DOCUMENT CHECKLIST

When you travel to IMG Academy, you must carry the following documents with you:

- Passport
- Visa
- Form I-20
- SEVIS receipt
- · Letter of acceptance from the school
- · The address of where you will be staying
- The telephone number of IMG Academy in case of travel delays or problems at the airport

DO NOT PACK THESE IN YOUR CHECKED BAGGAGE — Keep these documents at hand to show to the Customs Officials and when you come to the IMG Academy orientation.

PORT OF ENTRY: ARRIVING IN THE US

New (initial) students with an F-1 student visa may be admitted to the U.S. up to 30 days before their course of study begins.

Have the following documents available for presentation:

- Your passport
- Form I-20
- Customs declaration form (will be distributed by CBP officials)

All visitors entering the USA must state their reason for entering the country. If you are attending IMG Academy, and are in possession of a valid SEVIS form, tell the CBP Officer that you are a student.

Once your inspection to successfully completed, the inspecting officer will:

- Stamp your passport. For F-1 visa holders, the stamp must say D/S.
- Students who do not have "D/<u>S" written on their I-94 or on a stamp in their pas</u>sport must check their I-94 arrival record online: https://i94.cbp.dhs.gov/194/#/home. If you arrived in student status, your record will say F-1 D/S. In case it states anything else, please contact your International Student Advisor immediately. Students should report to their school within 30 days of the date that appears on the SEVIS I-20 form to register for courses or to validate their intended participation. Failure to do so may result in serious consequences.

IMG ACADEMY ORIENTATION

We will need a number of documents to facilitate the international orientation process. Please bring the following items to the orientation:

- Your passport with visa
- Original I-20 form (this document has three pages)

WHAT TO EXPECT ON CHECK-IN DAY

Check-In Day at IMG Academy is an exciting start to your journey with us! We strive to make this process as smooth and efficient as possible. Here's what you can expect:

DURATION

The check-in process typically takes about 1-2 hours. However, this timeframe can vary depending on how many pre-arrival tasks have been completed ahead of time.

ADDITIONAL TIME FOR BOARDING STUDENTS

If you are moving into the dorms, please plan for additional time beyond the initial check-in process to settle into your new home.

- Collect your welcome packet, checklist and MyIMG Card.

- Boarding students move into dorms with the help of our welcome team.
- Day students tour the campus and meet their day advisors.

1 HOUR: LUNCH BREAK

• Enjoy a meal in the Campus Center and mingle with fellow students and faculty.

AFTERNOON:

2 HOUR: FREETIME AND UNPACKING

• Settle in, unpack, and get comfortable in your new space.

1 HOUR: DAY MEET & GREET

• Day Families and Students can meet with the Student Life Day Manager.

1 HOUR: DINNER BREAK

• Enjoy a meal in our Campus Center or the Legacy Hotel Restaurant.

EVENING:

1 HOUR: SPORT ORIENTATIONS

 All students are required to attend their respective sports' orientation meeting to be introduced to the sport staff

END THE DAY: DORM FLOOR MEETINGS (ALL DORMS)

 All boarding students required to attend their floor meetings before curfew to meet their Primary Residential Mentor.


SCHOOLDOC - SET UP & INSTRUCTIONS

SchoolDcc

IMG Academy requires all campers to complete registration & health forms before participation in our Boarding School program, including an IMG Academy Physician's Report and immunization record.

To complete your required forms, you will need to set up an account on SchoolDoc. All required registration & health forms must be completed 30 days before campus arrival. If you have enrolled within 30 days of your arrival date, connect with the Boarding School Support team to ensure all forms are received and cleared prior to campus arrival. Once you have submitted all of your forms, our Boarding School Customer Support Team will review them to ensure that they have been filled out appropriately.

CAN'T ACCESS YOUR ACCOUNT?

- Visit <u>App.schooldoc.com</u>, and select Reset Password
- Use the email that you used to register for camp. Your camp advisor can pull this email address for you if you cannot remember.

- You'll be prompted to create an account with the email address you were invited with.

HOW DO I COMPLETE MY FORMS?

Forms need to be submitted via SchoolDoc. You should have received instructions on setting up your account in your confirmation email. If you have not received those details, please contact the Customer Support Team at IMGA.SchoolSupport@imgacademy.com.

WHAT IF I CAN'T COMPLETE ALL THESE FORMS BEFORE CHECK-IN?

Forms are required to be completed no later than 30 days prior to your camper's arrival. We are happy to help you as much as we can in order to get them complete, but failure to complete these forms can delay your camper's ability to participate in camp.

TEAMWORKS & BLACKBAUD – SET UP & INSTRUCTIONS



To enhance communication and improve operational inefficiencies, Teamworks was chosen to be implemented for use with our student-athletes and their families beginning with the 2022-23 school year. Teamworks is a comprehensive communication and logistics platform and is the industry standard at the collegiate and professional level. Key features of this platform include:

- DAILY/WEEKLY CALENDAR/SCHEDULES

Teamworks is the main platform for communication used by our sport and student life departments as well as our academic attendance and advisory staffs. Student-athletes and parents will have access to Teamworks via the app which is downloadable in the app store. An invitation to join the IMG Academy Teamworks account will be sent prior to check-in.



Blackbaud serves as the comprehensive student information and learning management system for IMG Academy.

To Create an IMG Academy Personal Spending Account Using a Credit Card:


*International credit card transactions will not go through as it requires zip code verification.

1. Go to the following URL on your internet browser: https://get.cbord.com/imgacademy/full/login.php or download the GET App.

2. Click the "Sign up now!" link below to register for an account.



3. For the ID number you will enter the GET Registration Number that begins with CON that you received in your camp confirmation email, first and last name of the student/camper you intend to setup the account for, your email, phone number and password and then press "Register."



4. You will receive an email confirmation, click on the link that says, "User Confirmation." After that you will sign in with your email address and password that you created. You will need to add funds to the DECLINING BALANCE. After you make a deposit, you will receive an email confirmation confirming the transaction was successful.

CONGRATULATIONS! You have completed the process and money has now been added to the personal spending account.

COURSE SELECTION

STEP 1:

Request your student's final official transcripts from their current school utilizing the form below.

RECORD REQUEST FORM

It is imperative that students successfully complete all of their coursework at their current school. Please do NOT withdraw your student prior to completion of course credit. STEP 2:

Once your student-athlete's official transcript has been received, you will receive a confirmation email from Transcripts@imgacademy.com. This email will include a link to book a course selection appointment with your College Counselor.

STEP 3:

• Student Life Residential Mentors

Residential Mentors serve as the point of contact and dedicated support staff within IMG Academy's residence halls. In addition, families can contact Residential Mentors as part of the more extensive support system widely available to each boarding school student-athlete. School student-athlete. With Residential Mentors assigned to each floor, they promote a positive living environment while uniting student-athletes and navigating the day-to-day of the students. Most importantly, our Student Life team is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

· Student Life Engagement

Our Student Engagement team organizes on-campus and off-campus activities during the students' free time outside of sport training and school. An activity schedule is released each week that includes all co-curricular activities, off-campus trips, community service, and student organization meetings. · Housing Office

The Housing Office is responsible for processing the Housing Applications through the Housing Portal for all Boarding Students. They will assign rooms and roommates based on specific criteria to ensure that you have been paired with the best possible roommate option for the academic year.

THE HOUSING PORTAL

The Housing Portal is where boarding students will fill out their Housing Application for the upcoming academic year. The Housing Application will allow you to confirm the demographic information we have on file, allow each student to answer several profile questions pertaining to their living and roommate preferences and give you the option to select a specific roommate to live with for the upcoming school year.





LAUNDRY BAG DISTRIBUTION

Each student is provided with a durable 25 lb. nylon laundry bag to use for their laundry needs. This bag is designed to hold a week's worth of laundry comfortably.

SCHEDULED DROP-OFFS

To streamline the process, we have designated two drop-off days each week. Students can leave their filled laundry bags in the designated bins located in the lobby of every dorm.

We guarantee a 48-hour turnaround time from drop-off to delivery, ensuring that students have a continuous supply of clean clothes.

VEHICLE AND PARKING INFO

VEHICLE POLICY:

WHAT ARE THE POLICIES, WHAT ARE ALLOWABLE?

- Students who are at least 18 years of age are permitted to have a vehicle on campus. They must register the vehicle with the Academy and provide a copy of the students' valid license, proof of insurance, and registration.
- Registration sticker must be displayed on the students' vehicle.
- Local Sign Out Policy form (p.48) with student and parent signatures must be on file.
- Car keys must be kept with Student Life staff at the corresponding dorm desk and may be checked out when the student signs out.

ON-CAMPUS TRANSPORTATION

- Golf carts, e-bikes, e-scooters, e-skateboards, and other like motorized modes of transportation are strictly prohibited for all student-athletes, including Day students, and guests at IMG Academy. Only IMG Academy staff are permitted to operate a golf cart.
- Non-motorized bicycles remain permitted (must be registered with Campus Safety).

PARKING:

Parents dropping off their students should park in the lot near the Welcome Center located in the Campus Center. Please ask the entry gate upon entering if you have questions regarding parking or directions.

IMG Academy offers a Tram Service to navigate campus upon arrival and during your student's stay. There is a tram stop located behind the Campus Center. If you are staying at Legacy Hotel, we also offer parking on-site as well as a Valet Cart service that operates upon request to campus.

- Parents can request a parking pass when entering/leaving campus from the Campus Safety staff at the gate.
- Please note, students will be permitted to utilize a ride sharing service (Uber, Lyft, etc.) to leave campus with an approval from parents through REACH.

REACH – SET UP & INSTRUCTIONS



IMG Academy has implemented the REACH Student Life Management system to enhance the safety and security of student-athletes.

REACH coordinates Leave Request procedures for School Staff, Parents/Guardians, Hosts (e.g., grandparents), and Boarders by creating an easy to use, paperless system, which is available from any PC or mobile device 24 hours a day, 7 days per week. REACH automates all Boarder Leave Request procedures by allowing parents/guardians to approve or reject leave requested by the student-athlete electronically.

Student-athletes will receive a separate tutorial with login and password reset instructions.


Please note that parents and guardians will not receive separate REACH accounts; leave requests will be generated from the student-athlete's account.

An approved REACH leave request is required each time a boarding studentathlete leaves campus unless it is an IMG Academy chaperoned trip. For detailed information regarding leave policies and procedures, please refer to the Student-Athlete and Parent Handbook.

THE PROCESS

- 1. The student-athlete will create a request to leave campus through the REACH system.
- 2. Based on Academy procedures, parents/guardians may be asked to verify and give permission for a particular leave. Parents/guardians will grant this permission through the automated email that REACH will send upon the student-athlete's submission of the leave request.
- 3. If approved by the parent/guardian, the action is recorded by the REACH system and will inform Student Life that permission has been granted.

WHAT MEASURES ARE IN PLACE TO KEEP MY STUDENT SAFE?

WEATHER SAFETY

In case of rain or inclement weather, all of our sport programs have a rain contingency plan for every session. Our coaches can pivot at a moment's notice in order to continue instruction safely.

Weather Safety Alerts will go into effect if lightning or other inclement weather is within a certain distance from the Academy. An alarm will sound to notify all staff and students that campus is under a weather safety alert. All persons must stay indoors until the weather safety alert is lifted. When the alert is lifted, a second alarm will sound to notify all persons on campus.

If students need to get anywhere while campus is under a weather safety alert is in effect, our transportation department will arrange for buses, vans or other forms of transportation to safely transport campers if necessary. If it is not deemed necessary, campers will stay put until the weather safety alert is lifted.

Johns Hopkins AII Children's Hospital provides the health care services for the students of IMG Academy. The Health Services team is honored to oversee your child's day to day health care. Health Services is an on campus facility open 24 hours per day. Care provided includes first aid, distribution of medication and supplements that are not permissible in the student's room, nurse visits or more complex physician appointments if needed during student's stay at IMG Academy. Health Services staff of nurses are available 24 hours a day to address your participant's medical needs. ADMINISTERING PRESCRIPTION MEDICATION WHILE AT IMG ACADEMY

Parents/guardians and students are required to provide Health Services with a current list of all medications, prescribed or over the counter, which

the student currently takes. It is the sole responsibility of the parent/guardian to notify Health Services in order to update the student's medication administration plan with respect to any medication(s), dosing revisions, and health status changes. Students who do not take medication as prescribed by their doctor or who fail to follow their doctor's orders may be considered unfit to participate in their sport program.

Parents of non-boarding students are expected to attend to students' medication needs outside of school whenever possible; however, if a non-boarding student must take a daily prescription medication during school hours, parents are expected to provide the medication in original prescription bottles with the instructions in English to Health Services for administration.

For health and safety reasons, it is our policy that Health Services administer prescription medication to boarding students. Daily prescription medication must be turned into Health Services upon check-in to school. All medications must be in the original prescription bottles with the instructions in English for administration with the student's name, date of birth and all prescribing information. Health Services will work with local pharmacies to fill prescriptions if this is necessary for your child while attending boarding school .

Medications will be dispensed by Health Services staff or by Academy personnel who have been designated in accordance with the Academy's policy regarding the administration of prescription medication. Students are required to report to Health Services to receive their prescription medication in accordance with their treatment plan and missing a required dosage may result in disciplinary action and/or removal from participation in their sport program.

WHAT HAPPENS IF MY STUDENT-ATHLETE DOESN'T COME TO TAKE HIS MEDICATIONS?

Notices are sent to sport, school, student life and your child that a medication dose has been missed. If the dose continues to be missed these messages are escalated and the parent/guardian are informed.

DO ALL MEDICATIONS FOR MY STUDENT-ATHLETE NEED TO BE KEPT IN HEALTH SERVICES EVEN THOUGH MY STUDENT-ATHLETE HAS MANAGED THEM ON THEIR OWN AT HOME?

Yes. There are only a few medications that student-athletes may keep in their rooms - among them emergency medications. A full list is available for you from Health Services.

WHAT HAPPENS WHEN MY STUDENT-ATHLETE IS SICK?

Your student-athlete is seen by a nurse in Health Services and assessed as to problem and plan for care. If your student-athlete is feverish or infectious they will remain in Health Services until that time has passed and they can be released. If a higher level of care is required, a physician appointment will be made in consultation with the parent/guardian.

Emergency allergy control medication (EpiPens), topical creams, cleansers, eye drops, inhalers, nasal sprays, oral contraceptives, insulin, ibuprofen, non-sedating and non-decongestant antihistamines including Zyrtec (Cetirizine), Claritin (Loratadine), and Allegra (fexofenadine); throat lozenges/cough drops and other over the counter medications approved in writing by Health Services.




