

HOME RUN DERBY – RULES

Format

Round 1: Eight (8) players will be selected to compete. Each player will have 3 minutes in this round to hit as many home runs as they can. Each batter is entitled to one (1) 45-second timeout that can be taken at any point during the round.

Round 2: The top four (4) home run totals from Round 1 will compete in Round 2. Each player will have 3 minutes in this round to hit as many home runs as they can. Each batter is entitled to one (1) 45-second timeout that can be taken at any point during the round.

Round 3: The top two (2) home run totals from Round 2 will compete in the Championship Round under the same rules as previous rounds.

Timeouts

For every round, each batter is entitled to one (1) 45-second timeout that can be taken at any point during the round.

<u>Ties</u>

In the event of a tie, a 60-second swing-off will take place with no stoppage of time. If two players still remain tied, three swing-offs take place until the tie is broken.
